DIRECTIONS

- Head out of Nairobi on the main Waiyaki Way towards Nakuru
- Turn off on the road towards Mai Mahiu and Naivasha that goes down the escarpment
- Then turn left onto the road to Narok
- In Narok get fuel and refreshments
- Then carry on out of Narok and turn off left onto the road to the Mara which is about 5 Kms out of Narok
- Cross the Uaso Nyiro River Bridge and turn left onto the road towards the Mara and Keekorok lodge (lots of sign boards). The Tarmac ends and carries on as a murrum road
- Then after a good run turn left onto the road to Naikara
- At the next major junction bear right towards the Mara (left road goes to Naikara)
- Continue on this road heading for Ololaimutia gate into the Maasai Mara
- In Ololaimutia stop outside the Balloon Safaris compound where someone on a motorbike will meet you (the camp manager will send you the name and mobile number of the motorbike escort nearer your travel date)
- Follow him to camp which is about an hour away. Please pay the motorbike escort Kshs 500; this is to cover for his fuel from Ololaimutia to camp and back

**For the motorbike to meet you, we need to know your arrival details 24 hours in advance **
