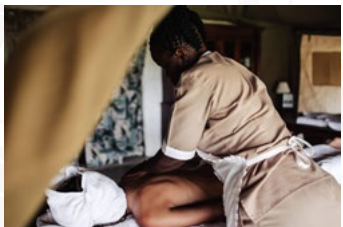

| BALLOON RIDE OVER THE MAASAI MARA | <p>The day begins with an early morning wakeup call at 3.30am with tea and coffee followed by a 4am departure to the launch site to enjoy a balloon safari over the Maasai Mara. The drive from camp to the balloon site takes about one and a half hours.</p> <p>At dawn you will board and take off, rising as the sun rises, floating in whichever direction the winds of the morning take you. The pilot controls the altitude of the balloon, sometimes flying at treetop height, sometimes lower. At other times he will ascend to one thousand feet or more to see the enormous and wonderful panorama of the Maasai Mara, offering a unique perspective and great photographic opportunities of the wildlife below. The flight will last about an hour and upon landing, you will enjoy a full english breakfast with a traditional champagne toast.</p> | 4am departure | US\$505 per adult \$400 per child 4 - 11 years (Children under 4 years not allowed) |
| COFFEE TASTING EXPERIENCE | <p>Take your taste-buds on a journey through some of East Africa's best coffees. Spend an hour or so one afternoon with one of our delightful waiters as he brews strong Rwandan, Ethiopian and Kenyan coffee for you using the siphon brewing method. The siphon is a visually stunning brewing method that uses vacuum filtration to push extremely hot water through a bed of freshly ground coffee.</p> <p>Thanks to a paper filter and a relatively quick extraction time, this technique creates an uncommonly nuanced and delicate cup that mesmerizes the senses. Our coffee expert will take you through the history of coffee in East Africa, whilst comparing the different tastes and aromas. He will explain how different climates and processing methods result in very different coffees. It's a must-do tasting experience for any coffee lover!</p> | 45 minutes | Included |

| WILDERNESS RUN/WALK WITH A MAASAI WARRIOR | Lower your carbon footprint and spend time learning more detailed, under-foot ecosystem functions. | GUIDED BUSH WALKS | <p>Exploring the bush on foot is one the most exhilarating African safari experiences, however, only very few wildlife conservancies in Kenya will allow you to get out of your vehicle. We offer bush walks for all ages and fitness levels. These are escorted nature walks just outside our camp to explore the close-range micro-universe first-hand, with emphasis on the walking, culture and scenery. Our interpretive guides will point out the spoor of a leopard, the nest of a rare bird or signs of recent wildlife activity that would pass unnoticed by the eyes of a stranger and can be overseen on a game drive.</p> <p>A walk is a wonderful way to look at the smaller critters, take an interest in the plant diversity and see the wild lands at a slower pace. All walks are led by a professional guide accompanied by a licensed gun bearer.</p> | 2-4 hours | Included |

Striving for a stable elephant population coexisting peacefully with people across the Greater Mara Ecosystem (GME). With 10 years of experience using their MEP method of boots on the ground rangers and applied research, all while taking a collaborative approach has disrupted poaching in the region and combatted conflict and habitat loss. This donation amount is all inclusive and supports not just MEP's helicopter, but also the core efforts of the organisation.</p> <p>A once-in-a-lifetime exclusive safari with the Mara Elephant Project. Get a behind the scenes experience in the protection of the elephants to conserve the Greater Mara Ecosystem (GME). | IMMERSIVE RAPTOR EXPERIENCE WITH KENYA BIRDS OF PREY TRUST (KBOPT). |  | \$780 | Half day. Subject to availability and needs at least one weeks notice | <p>Seven of Africa's 11 vulture species are on the edge of extinction, and poisoning is largely to blame. Vultures are often the unintended victims of poisoning incidents where humans place poison onto carcasses to kill carnivores such as lion and hyena. Poisoning is the primary cause of vulture mortality in the Mara, and we have witnessed unprecedented declines in these species over the last few decades.</p> <p>Someone from KBOPT will come to camp and do a presentation on all the vital work they do. Should there be a vulture or other bird being rehabilitated, the guests can visit it. Otherwise guests can go out for a game drive with KBOPT and learn more about how they are working to protect these keystone species and other raptors.</p> |
| MAASAI WARRIOR SCHOOL |  | Included | 1 hour | <p>The Maasai Warrior School showcases cultural and work skills a Maasai warrior needs in his daily life. Skills that are passed on from one generation to the next.</p> <p>Join our Maasai team and learn the skills of a Maasai Warrior. An age dependent engagement. For younger children the Maasai Warrior School includes fire making, spear throwing, bow and arrow practice, Maasai jumping, dancing and singing, and tracking. For grown-ups, it can be the same activities, or sit down and learn the roles and responsibilities of the Maasai community through their various age-groups.</p> |
| MARA CHEETAH EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE |  | \$780 plus an additional \$50 per person for the experience | Half day. Subject to availability and needs at least one weeks notice. | <p>An ongoing and age-old conflict between the Maasai people and predators has resulted in cheetah numbers being significantly affected, resulting in a third population decline in the last two decades. The Mara Meru Cheetah Project provides science for conservation on cheetahs and lions as well as enhancing understanding on predators' role within the broader ecosystem.</p> <p>Guests can choose from a range of experiences from a one-hour talk on cheetah with our guides, to spending a half-day out in the field followed by a talk with the head of Mara Meru Cheetah Project, Dr. Elena V.Chelysheva.hD</p> |
| ONE HOUR LEARNING WITH FEMALE CONSERVATION RANGERS |  | Included | Needs to be pre-arranged 2 hours prior | <p>Support the only all female ranger unit in the Maasai Mara, and the important conservation, community and cultural initiatives that they work on.</p> <p>Join the first female ranger team in the Maasai Mara and understand their goals and key challenges. When appropriate, participate in their daily activities patrolling, de-snaring, wildlife counting and liaison with the Maasai community.</p> |

| REFORESTATION SEEDBALL DISPERSAL ACTIVITY |  | First bag free, donations appreciated | | From your wildlife drive vehicle or whilst out on a walk, test your arm and aim as you throw seedballs around that will eventually sprout when the rains come. |
| VISIT OUR LOCAL MAASAI VILLAGE |  | \$20 per person | 2 hours | <p>Conservancy fees paid by guests are donated directly to Cottar's Wildlife Conservation Trust. CWCT uses these funds to lease the 7608-acre Olderkesi Conservancy from the Maasai community, who in turn use them for community and personal development. This is a unique conservation and community theory of change model for the Maasai Mara and for Africa, in that the community have decided to not subdivide the land; it remains as one plot set aside for conservation.</p> <p>Visit a Maasai village and experience their rich culture. This involves a trip to their Manyattas (mud huts), village setup (security, healthcare, education and management of resources such as meals, water, firewood), local market with wonderful Maasai artefacts/ attire for sale, their livestock, and much more. You will learn about ancient traditions as well as contemporary struggles and adaptations to modern life.</p> |
